- These courses are all worth three credits. Courses in these subjects at other institutions that transfer to the University of Colorado Boulder as less than 2.7 credits are not equivalent to our courses and will not be accepted.
- Courses in these subjects at other institutions that transfer to the University of Colorado Boulder as 2.7 credits or more will have to be evaluated individually by the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee. In order to obtain an evaluation, the student requesting credit must demonstrate that the course in question is essentially equivalent in content and challenge to these courses.
- If transfer credit is granted for one of these courses, students will receive three credits towards the completion of our major requirements regardless of the number of transfer credits accepted by the University of Colorado Boulder.
